We ensure all our prison officers are trained in how to use PAVA professionally, safely and lawfully and that it is only used when necessary and proportionate.

We are unable to provide data regarding age or disability. Disability data has not been captured historically and therefore there is a lack of integrity of the data. Age would require significant data extraction, which exceeds the disproportionate costs amount.
